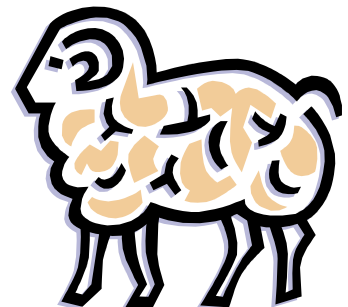
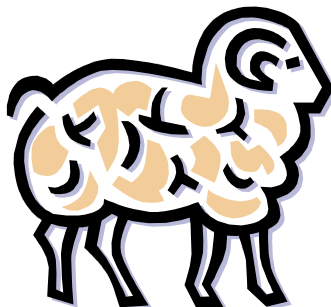
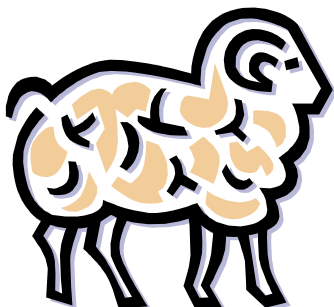
PURPOSE: Students may travel to any Australian or overseas destination to further their research.
